### ~ WHITE ~

**Siegrist, Riesling, "15", Auslese Trocken, {Dry}** Pfalz, Germany 2007 36  
*Thomas Siegrist took over his family's estate in 1974, and has built an international reputation for stellar wines. This is his favorite wine he makes. It is made from grapes of Auslese level ripeness (any more than that it becomes dessert wine), but is fermented completely dry. "15" has a rich, viscous texture, but is still incredibly light on its feet. It shows white peach, orange blossom, and nectarine zest flavors.*

**Martinelli, Chardonnay, Zio Tony Ranch** Russian River Valley, CA 2008 40  
*Any discussion about the best chardonnays made in California will easily include Martinelli. The family has been farming these lands for generations, since it was an apple orchard up until the 1970's. With Helen Turley leading the winemaking efforts, these wines are truly world class. The creamy texture, creme brûlée nose, and ripe roasted apples on the palate all intermingle for a truly lovely wine. Get it while it lasts!*

**Regis Bouvier, Pinot Noir** Burgundy, France 2009 47  
*En la Rue de Vergy, Lieut-Dit, Morey Saint Denis AOC*  
*The domaine of Regis Bouvier has extensive vineyard holding throughout Burgundy. They are one of the great old school producers of Pinot Noir in the region. This is a great example of what has given Morey Saint Denis its well deserved reputation for meaty wines, while still retaining the elegance and prettiness of Pinot Noir. 2009 is reputed to be an amazing vintage. See 'why' for yourself.*

**Arietta, "Variation I", (Merlot/Syrah Blend)** Napa Valley, CA 2007 45  
*Owner Fritz Hatten is a wine professional to the core. He is the head auctioneer for both Zachy's & The Napa Valley Wine Auction among others. Winemaker Andy Erickson is one of the most sought after talents in California. His winery clients are a who's who of the best Napa Valley has to offer; most recently including the iconic Screaming Eagle. Variation I is one of the best wines this dynamic duo makes. The 50/50 blend of Syrah & Merlot is extremely smooth with black plums, cherries, and chocolate tannins. I'll bet even Miles from Sideways would drink this Merlot!*
